

## REMINDER: CHARTERED MEMBERSHIP EXAMINATION APPLICATION DUE DATES

For those who are considering taking the **April 2011** Chartered Membership Examination (CME) of the Institution of Structural Engineers (IStructE), please note the following key dates:

For those who are a member of Engineers Australia with CPEng status (MIEAust CPEng) (OR are CEng registered with the Engineering Council through ICE, CIBSE, RINA, IET, RAeS, IMechE or IMarEST OR MIEI members (Republic of Ireland) OR IPENZ Professional Members, who have undertaken an IPENZ competence assessment and who are of CPEng (New Zealand) status)

You can apply through a Mutual Recognition Agreement and **Form M/MRA** must be submitted to the headquarters (UK) by **20 November 2010**.

For those to whom the above are not applicable

You can apply through one of the following routes:

- Individually Managed IPD (Initial Professional Development) Route (e.g. those who have kept, since graduate, IPD Quarterly Reports, Progress Summary Records, Personal development records etc.)
- Accredited Training Schemes Route
- Retrospectively Collated Route

and **Form M** must be submitted to the headquarters (UK) by **1 September 2010** with the following accompanying documents:

- A two-page experience report
- IPD Final Report Form for each of the 13 core objectives

In addition to the above documents, depending on the route applicable to you, you will be required to submit additional documents later (refer to the Form M for details).

Once your application is accepted, you will be required to attend the Professional Review Interviews with our local members in **November/December 2010**.

Most of candidates in Australia are likely to go through either a Mutual Recognition Agreement or Retrospectively Collated Route and we have a few members who have recently experienced either route and can assist you further.
